The **Yellow House Community (YHC)** is a State licensed Therapeutic Community Residence located in downtown Middlebury. We provide residential support to a household of four young adults ("Friends") with intellectual and developmental disabilities. We are looking for team players who are patient, reliable, and passionate about working with individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities to join our growing staff in the following roles:

"FOODIE" (25 hours per week; some evenings req'd)

The Foodie oversees food services for our residence with an emphasis on healthy, local foods. Our ideal candidate has a culinary background and experience budgeting, ordering, and preparing wholesome food for a small group. Knowledge of nutrition and local foods preferred.

OVERNIGHT SUPPORT WORKER (PT; Shift hours: 9pm – 7am)

The Overnight Support Worker (OSW) is responsible for the overnight care and supervision of YHC's four young adult residents. The OSW sleeps at Yellow House and awakens to respond to Friends' needs and emergencies with support from live-in staff.

EVENING SUPPORT WORKER (PT; Anticipated hours: 3pm – 9pm)

The Evening Support Worker (ESW) collaborates with YHC staff to assist Friends with nighttime activities including dinner preparation, games, social events (inside and outside of YHC), household chores, personal/hygiene care, and bedroom routines.

CO-WORKER (FT; Year-long stipend position)

Co-workers are special members of our life-sharing staff who commit to a year of community service (similar to AmeriCorps volunteers) and live onsite at the Yellow House. They receive free room and board, generous time off, and a weekly stipend. Co-workers may be recent graduates, graduate-level students, or comparable. Along with seasoned YHC staff, Co-workers assist Friends with day programming activities including meal prep., exercise, personal/hygiene care, community engagement, art, music, jobs, and farm-based programming.
