The Yellow House Community Foodie can commit to 3+ evening shifts per week (approx. 3pm – 8pm), one weekend morning per week, and additional shift(s) for meal planning and bulk meal preparation.

Position Type: Part-Time (approx. 25 hours per week)

Responsibilities:

- Monthly meal planning for residents and staff, taking into consideration dietary restrictions
- Budgeting, ordering, and shopping for weekly meals
- Maintaining records for licensing and accounting purposes
- Onsite dinner preparation and cleanup three nights per week (will involve one Friend and/or volunteer)
- Onsite brunch preparation and cleanup on Saturday mornings (will involve one Friend and/or volunteer)
- Food preparation for additional meal offerings
- Communicating facilities-related needs to the YHC Executive Director
- Collaborating with the YHC Nurse Affiliate to meet the dietary needs of residents
- Fostering a culture of joy, kindness, and FUN!

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent required
- Culinary experience required – menu planning, budgeting, ordering, and food preparation
- Background in nutrition preferred
- Ability to perform well in an environment that requires compassion, helpfulness, patience, and resourcefulness
- Passion for working with people with intellectual and developmental disabilities
- CPR/First Aid certification required (training provided)
- Criminal background clearance required
- Basic accounting skills preferred
- Valid driver's license preferred
