About Us:

The Yellow House Community (YHC) is a State licensed Therapeutic Community Residence located in downtown Middlebury, Vermont. We currently provide support to a household of four Residents with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (ID/DD) in the Yellow House. We are looking to grow our program to support an additional four Residents in the newly renovated Carriage Barn. YHC seeks individuals who are compassionate, patient, reliable, comfortable responding to a crisis/emergency, passionate about working with adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities, and team players.

Job Summary

The Sidekick partners with the Program Director to support Residents with social, Residential and vocational activities and outings. The Sidekick is committed to the Yellow House team but does not live on site. The Yellow House Community employs Daytime and Evening Sidekicks to support the Residents during awake hours. Daytime Sidekicks help Residents complete morning routines and engage in active daily programming. Evening Sidekicks support programming and aid in evening routines.

Key Deliverables

- Foster a culture of joy, kindness and FUN!
 - Participate in social, Residential and vocational outings and activities
 - Model a positive attitude and willingness to participate in all programming activities
- Ensure Residents are receiving excellent physical care and emotional support
 - Assist Residents with personal/hygiene care and follow personal hygiene plans
 - Assist Residents in maintaining a clean and safe home environment
 - Offer physical and emotional support as needed
 - Support Residents in making activity choices during downtime
 - Cook or prepare daily meals with Residents
 - Administer medications as directed
 - Transport Residents in the YHC van
- Maintain a clean and safe home environment
 - Perform household tasks such as daily cleaning and laundry with Residents
 - Communicate with Program Director about facility issues
 - Support the Residents in maintaining the Yellow House Community Garden
